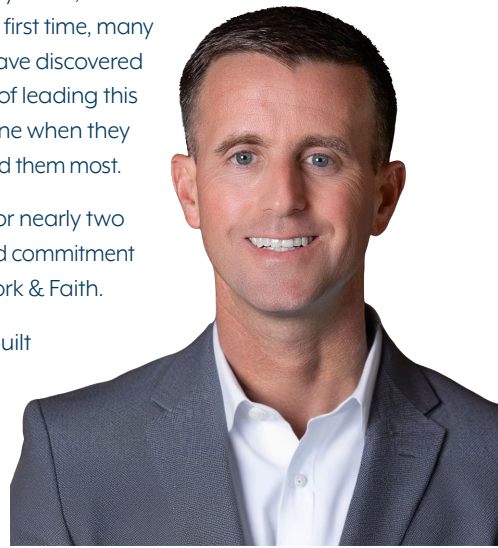
MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

MAIGAN KING

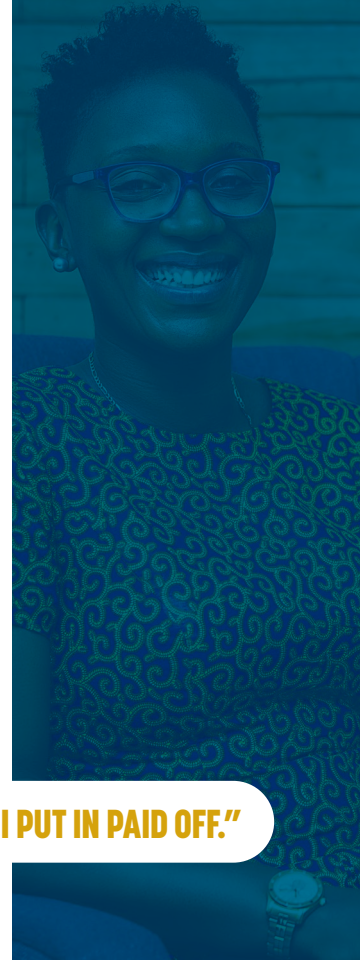

A single mother of two, she had always worked hard but faced financial challenges that led her to seek shelter. As her departure from the shelter approached, Maigan completed the Job Search Accelerator class in November 2023.

With no degree but strong experience as a contract specialist, she was determined to find meaningful, stable work. Her WorkFaith coach helped her refine her resume, prepare for interviews, and connect with Dress for Success Houston.

Despite mobility issues, Maigan regularly used the Resource Center and local library to job search. She remained involved in her children's lives while diligently pursuing opportunities.

Her hard work paid off. Maigan is now a full-time Contract Administrator at Atlas Copco Compressors, earning \$70,000 annually. She's moved her family into their own home and continues to build a stronger future.

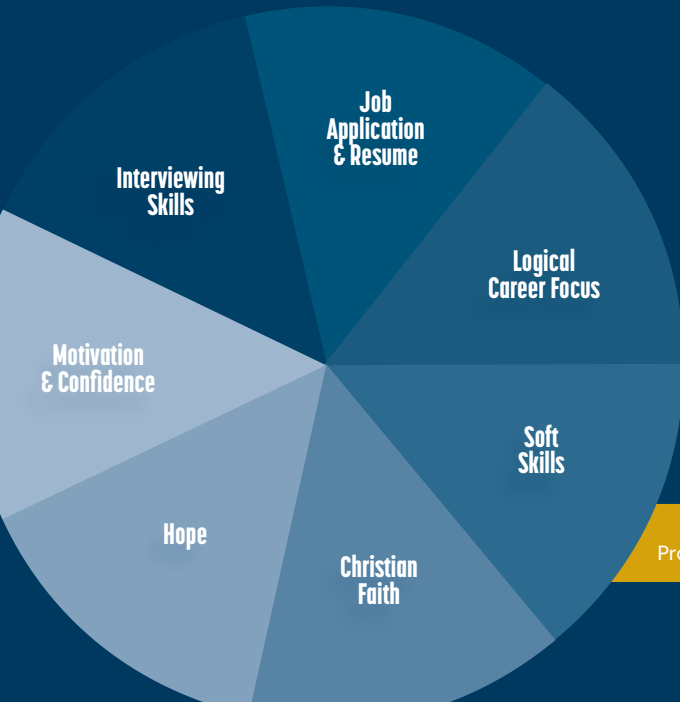
AVERAGE WAGE RATE OF

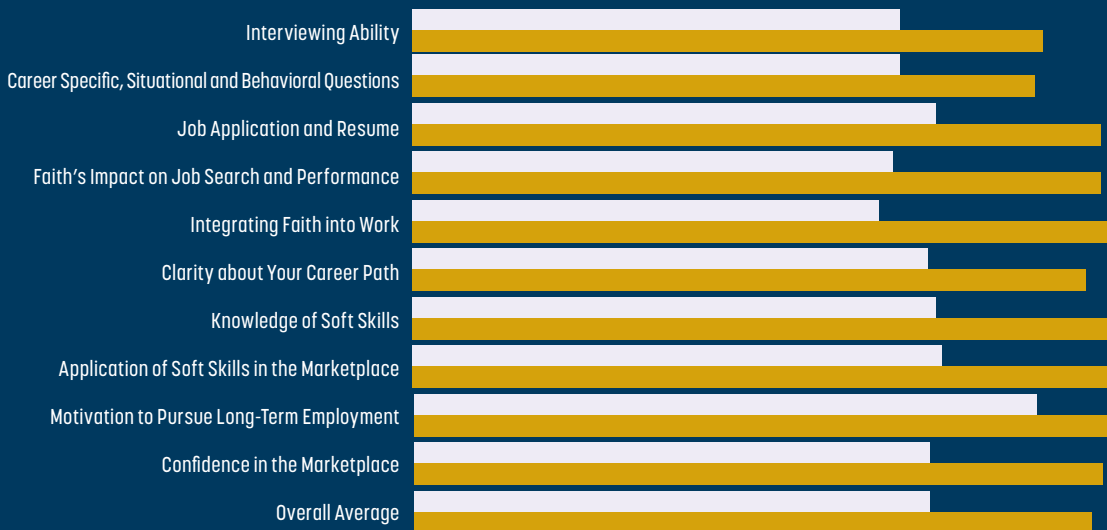
A HOLISTIC APPROACH TO EMPLOYMENT

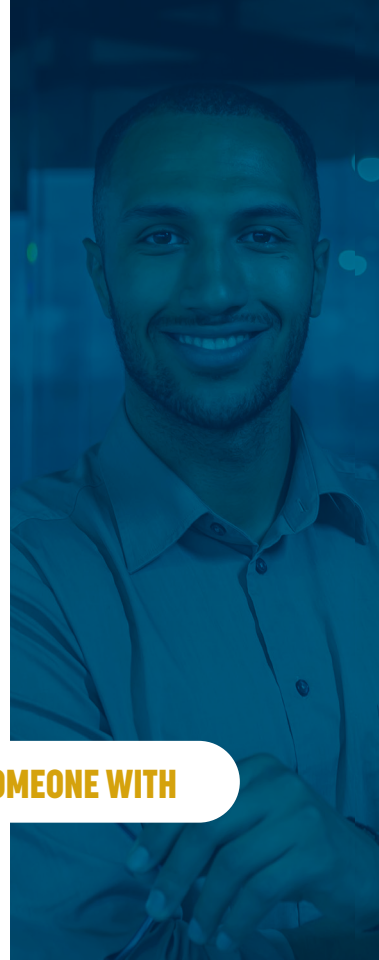

Omar grew up in a strict religious environment where faith was forced rather than chosen, leading him to rebel early. After moving to the U.S., his destructive path deepened—by high school, he was caught in drugs, addiction, unstable jobs, and prison time. His reckless choices cost him relationships, financial stability, and the support of his family. Eventually, addiction consumed his life, leaving him isolated and broken. When he lost his job and wrecked his car, Omar ended up homeless, sleeping under a bridge, wondering how his life had collapsed.

Seeking change, Omar joined WorkFaith for structure and accountability. There, he gained practical job readiness skills, learned how to address his past with confidence, and discovered how faith could guide his recovery and decisions. Applying these lessons, Omar grew stronger, secured opportunities, and eventually stepped into a leadership role overseeing an education department. Today, he lives with renewed purpose, gratitude, and hope for a future far different from his past.

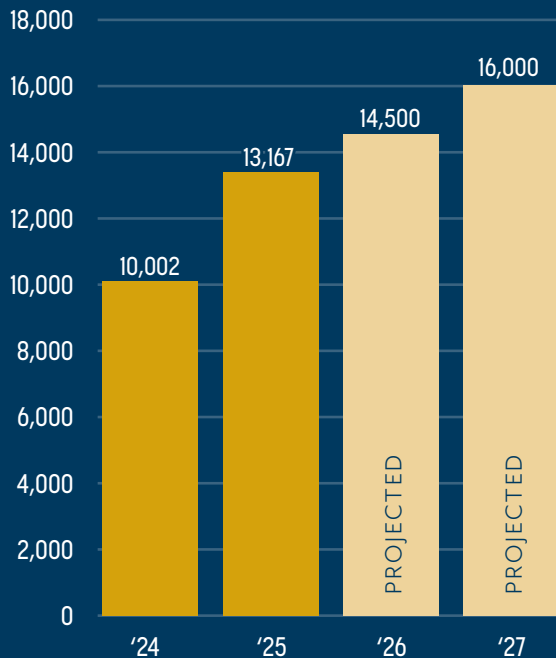

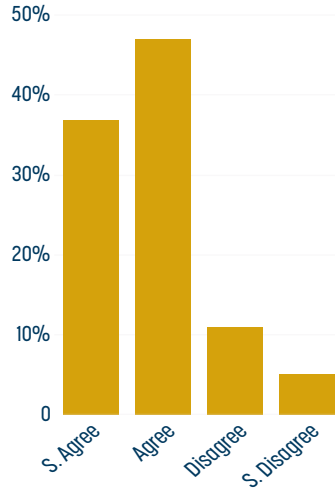
WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

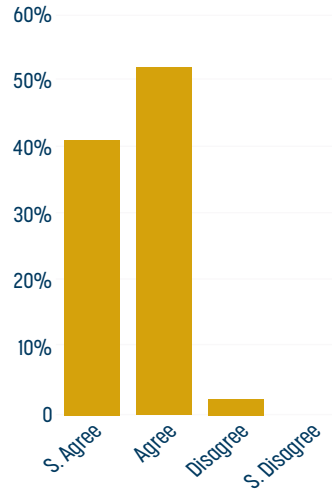
THE JOURNEY TO EMPLOYMENT

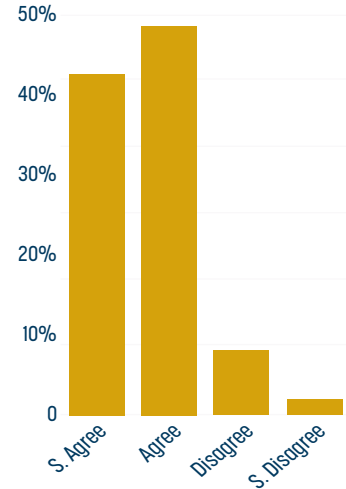
PERCEIVED SKILLS

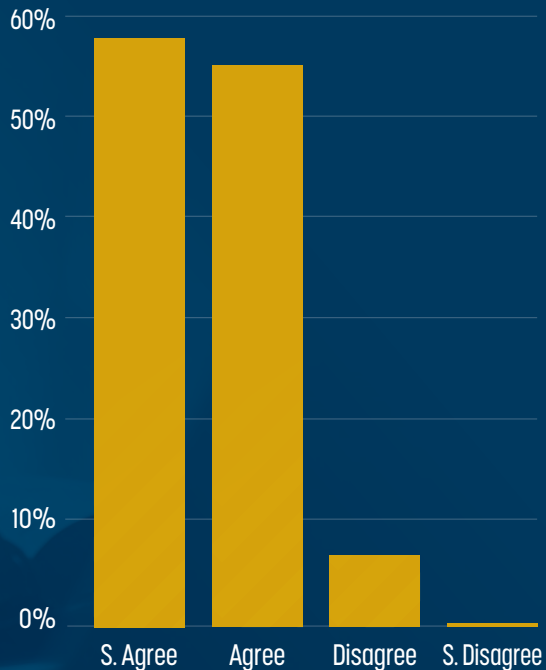
SPIRITUAL GROWTH

BENITA PARKER

Benita's world was shattered when her son was killed in a violent crime. Given only a week off from work, she returned still deep in grief—only to be laid off due to performance. Another job ended the same way. Even a counselor told her he couldn't help. Overwhelmed and hopeless, Benita left Illinois and drove to Houston to be near her daughter, hoping for a fresh start.

Despite her master's degree in HR Management, three months passed with no job offers. She was low on funds and facing homelessness. Desperate, she contacted a local shelter, which referred her to WorkFaith. There, she met Coach Nate.

Nate helped her revamp her résumé, tailor her job applications, and approach networking with strategy and confidence. More importantly, the faith-based support gave Benita renewed strength and hope.

Within weeks, she landed an interview with Baker Hughes. Using the tools she gained, she made a strong impression, secured a position as a Sourcing Specialist, and negotiated a solid salary.
